Yamada Sushi

Description: below act 2 is amazing. Jorge is fluent in English and super awake. The guy came up to me 2 years ago and asked me if I had ever heard of David Icke

I didn't even say anything ideological to him before he asked me. He told me from April 2020 that the whole thing is a scam to depopulate.

He's unjabbed though the staff mostly are. Voluntarily. The sushi is amazing. As is the hibachi. He used to cook in Las Vegas and is a dual citizen.
